

A Cicada Studio Tutorial: How To Make A Set Of Bibs

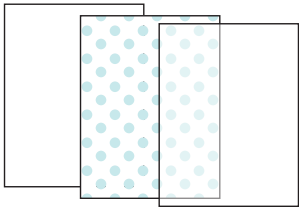

GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES TO MAKE A SET OF THREE STAIN-PROOF BIBS

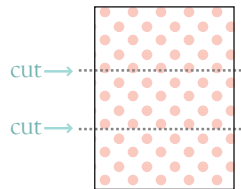
- 4 swatches of fabric each measuring 8.5 x 13 inches
- Scissors (pinking shears are not recommended)
- Iron
- Heat n Bond Vinyl® iron on vinyl (2yd x 17" package will be more than enough)
- 2- 4 yard packages Wright's® 1/4" double fold bias tape

- 1** Cut and iron on vinyl according to manufacturer's directions to all 4 fabrics.

*Do both sides of the fabric, especially the pocket panel, if you feel staining will be an issue.

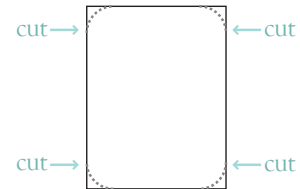


- 2** Decide which of the 4 fabrics will be used as the pocket on all 3 bibs. Cut it in equal thirds.

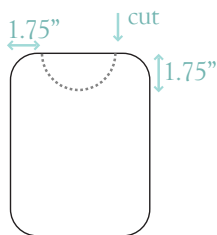


- 3** On wrong side of all body fabric, mark and cut rounded corners.

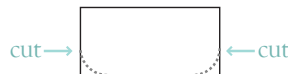
*I used the inside of a roll of masking tape as template.



- 4** Mark and cut a neckline that dips 1.75" down and 1.75" from the side edges.



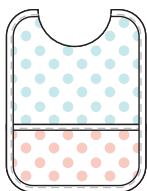
- 5** Repeat step 3 on the bottom edge only of the 3 pocket parts.



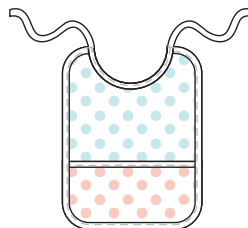
- 6** Sew binding to top edge of pocket.



- 7** Position pocket along bottom edge of body and sew binding from shoulder to shoulder.



- 8** Sew binding at neckline, starting 6" from end, and leaving 6" at other end.



- 9** Make tight knots at the end of the ties.
